## Could be an Earth-shaker

THE newly crowned Miss Harlem Shake is downright unshakable.

The uptown burger-and-milkshake joint has handed Ijeoma Eboh (photo), a 23-year-old Harvard University grad, its Golden Milkshake Cup and anointed her as its new poster girl.

It wrapped up a fierce contest that kicked off in May with 55 hopefuls.

The Jersey-reared Eboh – who has called Harlem home for two years – is pursuing a doctoral degree in the history and ethics of public health at Columbia University.

She aspires to one day start an organization to tackle obesity, diabetes and asthma – all major health issues that disproportionately afflict residents of Harlem and other poorer neighborhoods.

“Everything that we do, whether it’s the safety of our streets, health of our food options, the education we provide, it all largely affects our youth,” said Eboh, who also works as a health educator at Harlem Children’s Zone.
