"We're ready to let summer begin by rereleasing Del's Shandy and our top notch Summer Ale after the record-breaking winter we had this year in New England," said Mark Hellendrung, president of Narragansett Beer, in a release. "The response to Del's Shandy last year was so unbelievable."

An account executive with Marlo Marketing, who represents Narragansett Beer, told me via email Del's Shandy was released in mid-May last year, with the summer ale coming in April-May.

"It's becoming a trend in the industry to release seasonals earlier and earlier (e.g. pumpkin beers in August) but 'Gansett traditionally waited a little longer," she said. "So while the release aligns with the industry, 'Gansett sped it up after the crazy winter."
