Penna says: "She looks like a Greek goddess! She's nailed everything with this ensemble. If she wanted to spice it up, I'd suggest incorporating a delicate braid on one side of the part, which would echo the stitching on the dress' bodice. But I also think she looks great as issometimes, less is more!"



CAREY MULLIGAN

Penna says: "Overall, I like Carey's look. Her outfit pays homage to Betty Draper. but her pixie cut gives it a modern edge. I think Carey could use some lowlights, however, to make her hair contrast a little more dramatically against her porcelain skin tone. But she wears the pixie cut well!"

Penna says: "I like what Amber did with her hair; the simple, sleek ponytail paired with the sassy little black dress is sexy yet professional looking. Her face shape is perfect for this type of style, and the pouf is a simple way to add an extra dose of glam to the outfit."





BLEDEL Penna says: "The dress looks great on her; she looks elegant and sophisticated, but her hair is messy, like she wasn't done getting ready. I think a loose, textured bun would've been better. It would complement the ruffles on the dress and draw more attention to her neckline and

collarbone."
