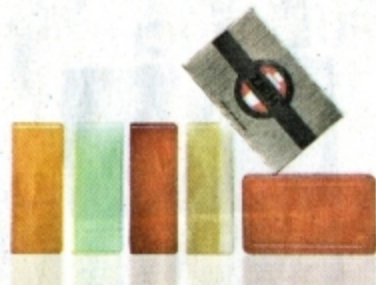

Two "targets" can be aligned with the mounting hardware to mark the spacing. Because each target has an opening in the center, the household handyman can make two properly spaced and level pencil marks in one step. Rubbery grip pads make it easier to hold the level in place with one hand.
