Geoff Auslen (standing) and Drew Koven, who founded Geoff & Drew's Cookies in 2001, are busy feeding couples' inner cookie monsters. Their three-tiered chocolate-chip wedding cookie cake, for one, offers the best of both baked worlds. And it costs less than \$100. They even encourage guests to throw cookies, instead of the usual birdseed, at the bride and groom: Geoff & Drew's Cookie Confetti are actually hundreds of flingable mini, well-rounded cookies—not jaggedly threatening crumbs. Or if you'd rather toss the baked goods back at your guests, consider putting Geoff & Drew's Cookies in gift bags. Auslen and Koven launched the company as a delivery service to Boston-area colleges and now have the honor of being the best-selling cookies on Amazon.com. For a recent engagement party, their cookie catering included customizing the favors, tying little bags of cookies with ribbon and a poem selected for the occasion by the bride's aunt. "We let people make their own decisions," says Koven. "That's how we started the wedding business. They pick the raw materials and ask us, 'How can I make this work?' Then we put it all together-with cookies." What a tasty idea.
