

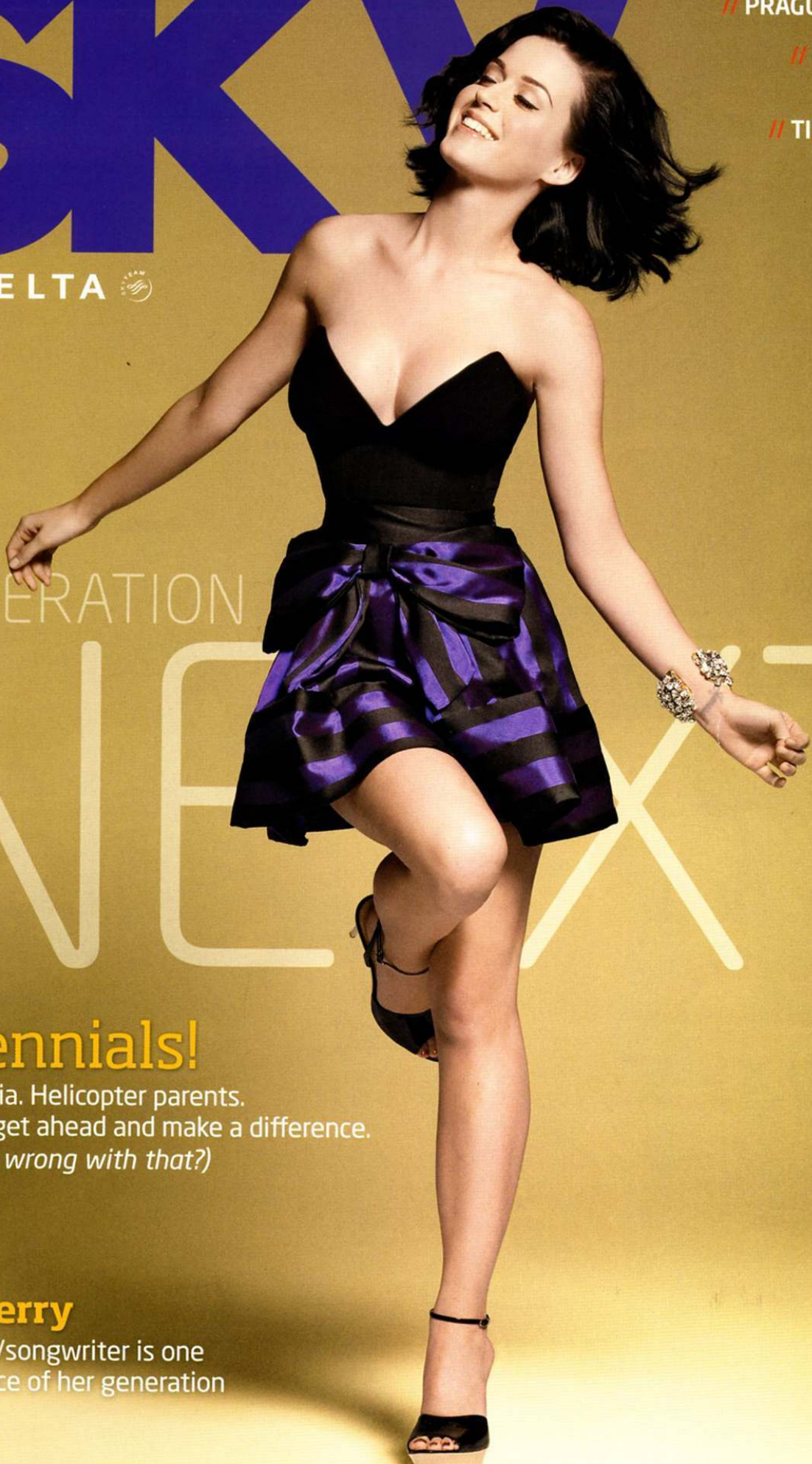

Atlanta // As one of the country's largest free jazz festivals, the **Atlanta Jazz Festival** returns to Piedmont Park on Memorial Day weekend. Nantucket // Thirty miles off the Massachusetts coast, Nantucket is a crescent-shaped island to which Americans flock during summer vacations.
