# Sophisticated Lady

**JACKSON CANNON** serves a mocktail with a touch of class.

I like to make sure our nonalcoholic drinks are just as well-balanced as our cocktails—just without the alcohol. I've given the drink to the staff to blind-taste and asked them to name the spirit. Often, they guess gin or vodka. I call it a Sophisticated Lady because the drink looks as elegant as a well-made

Cosmopolitan. When you taste it, you get the balance of sweet and tart with the cranberry, along with a little herbaceous note from the cucumber. 4 thick, round  
slices of  
cucumber  
pinch of salt

**1**  
Muddle 3 cucumber  
slices in a shaker with  
the pinch of salt.

2 ounces  
cranberry  
juice  
1 ounce  
fresh lime  
1 ounce  
simple syrup

**2**  
Add cranberry juice, lime juice,  
and simple syrup. Fill with  
ice, shake vigorously. Strain  
through a fine tea strainer into  
a chilled martini glass. Garnish  
with remaining cucumber slice.
