Just as the weather starts to warm up again next spring, the Frost Ice Bar, Boston's first bar made entirely out of ice, is set to open at Faneuil Hall.

Ice bars have been trendy around the world for several years, and can already be found in London, Tokyo and Milan.

The Frost Ice Bar in Boston will be kept at a chilly 24 degrees Fahrenheit, will be constructed entirely of ice and will feature a changing range of beverages and decor. The opening is set for spring of 2013.

The concept for a year-round ice bar in Boston was launched by the Frost Group LLC, in collaboration with [Boston Duck Tours](#).
