

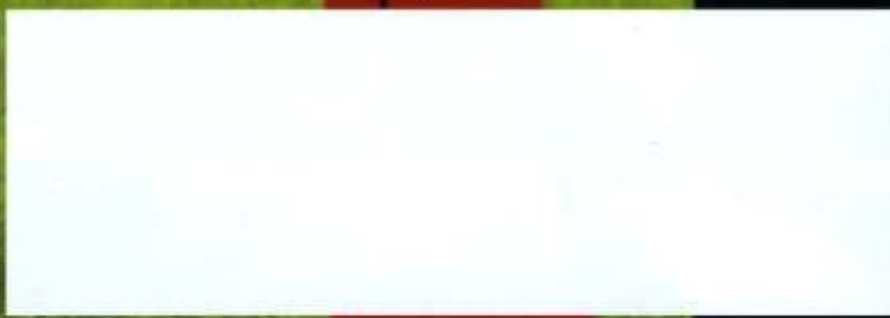

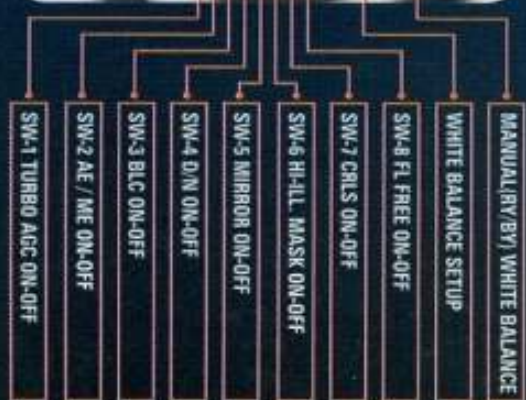
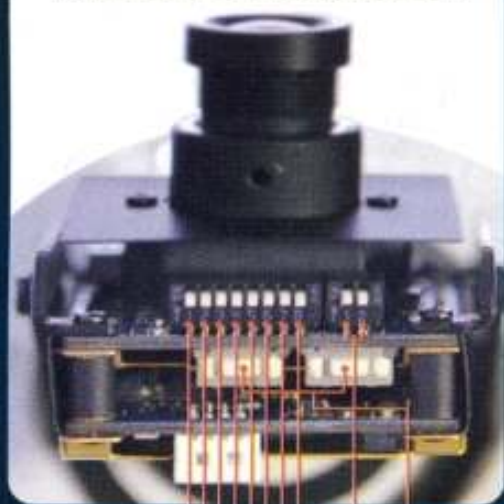

Viewpoint Opens New Video Command Center



Viewpoint CRM marked a major milestone with the unveiling of its new command center in Lowell, Mass. The center is the largest video monitoring operation of its kind in the nation.
