


Tress trends: 14 looks to rock in 2014

Femme flower crown


Ditch the big boho crown for a dainty update. Prim florals are darling with a low, loose bun.

SLICK SIDE PART

Flip your hair to one side right above the arch of either brow. Keep strands ultra straight, OK?

INVISIBLE PART

Pull back all the hair between the ends of your brows. Pin in place.

MESSY CENTER PART

Prep your mane with texturizer then blow-dry (sans brush). Part it in the center for a breezy look.

Braids: still hot in 2014

Psst: Braids hold best if you skip a wash, says hair pro Nicholas Penna Jr. of Boston. On it!



BITTY BRAID

- 1. Prep locks with a volumizing mousse, then blow-dry with a large, round brush.
- **2.** Part hair on one side, using a comb to pull it back diagonally.
- Grab a 2-inch section of hair and braid, then secure with an elastic. Mist hair with texturizer for a messy finish.



MERMAID BRAID

- 1. Braid two small sections of hair behind each ear and tie off with clear elastics.
- 2. Gather all hair together and pull back. Backcomb for volume. Section off the top half and pin to create a half updo.
- Messily braid remaining hair together, secure with an elastic. Mist with hairspray.



CROWN BRAID

- 1. Part hair down the center. Pull into two pigtails and secure behind the ear.
- 2. Braid both pigtails and tie off the ends with clear elastics.
- 3. Pull both braids up to meet at the top of your head, then tuck in a few bobby pins to keep it in place. Hairspray, please.



WARRIOR BRAID

- 1. Grab a 4-inch section of hair in the center of your head. Clip the two side sections out of the way.
- 2. Starting at your forehead, French braid the center, working backward (head to girlslife.com/iti for the how-to).
- 3. Secure with an elastic. Very fierce.

Sneaky slick-back

Bad hair days, be gone: A tiny bit of pomade and hairspray are all ya need to rock this grunge-yet-glam runway look.



Sweep loose, wavy strands over one shoulder and pin near the nape of your neck to keep 'em in place.





Tucked headband

Punctuate your pony with a headband atop your locks, tucking the ends of your tail into the band. Insta style, zero work.

Doublewrapped pony
