## Pups in Paris

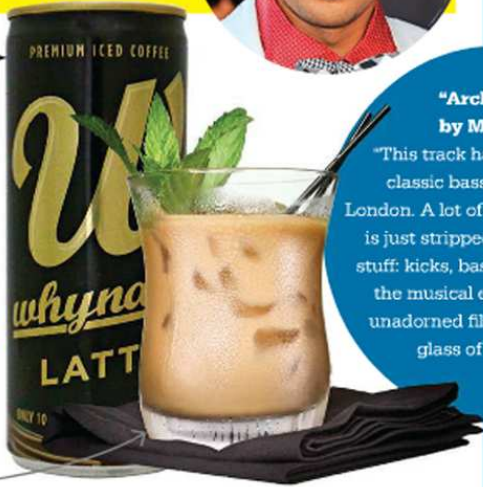

### "Archive 01" by Midland:

"This track has an absolutely classic bass line—it's very London. A lot of great dance music is just stripped-down, minimal stuff: kicks, bass and a vocal. It's the musical equivalent of an unadorned filet mignon and a glass of red wine."

### "For Peckham" by Black Dominoes:

"I recorded this in London [last] winter on a really cold day. I was not in a good mood while making this, but it's the best thing I've ever done."

### "Black Technician" by Robert Hood:

"[It's] really beautiful, rolling, colorful Detroit techno—like a Jackson Pollock painting with a black background."

### "Late Night Jam" by Levon Vincent:

"I just had the privilege of hearing George Fitzgerald play this at the Berghain/Panorama Bar in Berlin at about 8AM—maybe the best club and best club sound system in the world right now."

### "S.E.X (A.O.L Remix)" by Omar S:
