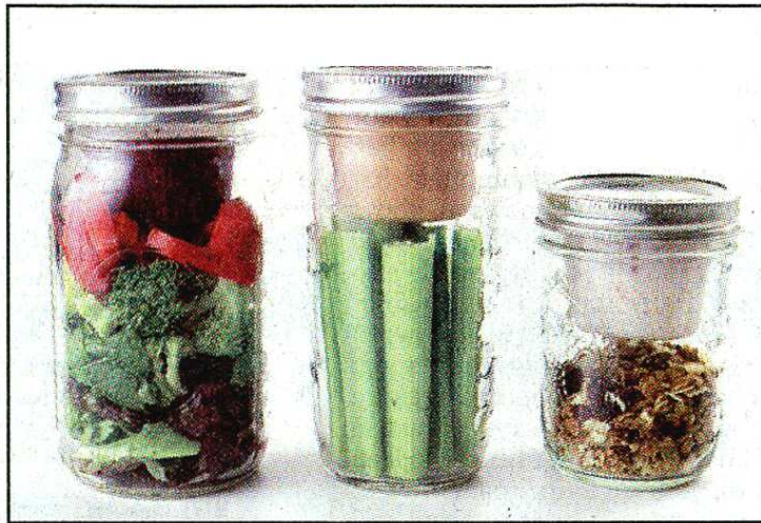

Mason jars as drinking glasses are old hat here in the South, but Mason jars as sip-top travel cups and lunch boxes are new on our radar. The transformation is easy thanks to Cuppow adapters.

For a spill-resistant sip-top cup the Cuppow plastic lid is placed between the jar and screw-on band. The lid features a spout similar to the lid used on take-out coffee and children's sippy cups. Made of BPA-free recycled plastic (Bisphenol A is a synthetic compound found in many hard plastics; studies suggest exposure to BPA can be harmful to infants and children), the lids come in regular and wide-mouth sizes. Hand-washing them is recommended.

The BNT0 adapter also fits between the jar and screw

band, but features a 6-ounce canister for separating ingredients such as salad dressing for a salad or dip for vegetables in a wide-mouth jar. Top rack dishwasher safe.
